Greetings.

Submit a flexible or rough budget – how much for project materials, personnel, supplies, transportation, utilities, etc. etc. Would it be self-sustaining? What is the total cost? If your project cost exceeds our AIHF funding, include any matching contributions from your members if any? Who is the contact person, his email or postal address and telephone number, in case we need to follow up or ask for clarification. Who are responsible and accountable for the implementation and management of the project? Include other ideas you believe would give you a better chance to be selected. Remember, the more feasible and doable your project, the greater credibility you have with the review committee here.

Due to financial constraints, we could only support one project at this time and AIHF will award the funding of the best project selected up to \$5,000.00. For your information, each entry will be weighted as follows:
